Life Membership/Playing Life Membership (Draft) to be voted at AGM.

Life Member Requirements

A life membership is the highest award available to recognize the exceptional contribution of individuals to the Port Augusta Darts Association. It is therefore only to be awarded in exceptional circumstances.

- For a member to be eligible for Life Membership they must have outstanding and continuous service to the association for a minimum of ten (10) years.
- Life Membership may be considered by the committee if a member has accumulated a total of 50 points calculated by using the table below.
 - Financial playing member of the Association (1 point)
 - Committee member (1 point)
 - Executive Committee (2 points)
 - PADA Representative Player (Men's Country or Brian Clarke, SA Junior/Senior Teams) (1 point)
 - Team Captain (1 point)
 - Representative Team Official (Men's Country or Brian Clarke) (1 point)
 - Outstanding service to the Association (Other) (1 point)
- All nominations for Life Membership must be in writing and received by the Association Secretary at least twenty-eight (28) days prior to the Annual General Meeting. The nomination must contain details of the nominees' outstanding and continuous service. i.e. Full details of the members history.
- The life membership nomination will be tabled at the next committee and either endorsed or rejected by the committee.
- The nominations endorsed by the committee will be tabled at the next Annual General Meeting and must be voted on by the members present, 75% of members present must agree for the endorsement to be accepted.
- Those nominations rejected by the committee will be returned to the nominator with an explanation as to why the nomination was not endorsed.
- A maximum of 2 Life Memberships will be awarded per year.
- Life Member Benefits
 - Nil Association registration fees for life. (currently \$40)
 - An invitation to Presentation night with benefits if no longer an active member.

Playing Life Membership Requirements

- For a member to be eligible for Playing Life Membership they must have continuous and actively been a member of the association for a minimum of twenty (20) years.
- Member must have displayed conduct that aligns with good sportsmanship, respect for teammates, opponents and officials.
- All nominations for Playing Life Membership must be in writing and received by the Association Secretary at least twenty-eight (28) days prior to the Annual General Meeting. The nomination must contain details of the nominees' outstanding and continuous service. i.e. Full details of the members history.
- The playing life membership nomination will be tabled at the next committee and either endorsed or rejected by the committee.
- The nominations endorsed by the committee will be tabled at the next Annual General Meeting and must be voted on by the members present, 75% of members present must agree for the endorsement to be accepted.
- Those nominations rejected by the committee will be returned to the nominator with an explanation as to why the nomination was not endorsed
- A maximum of 2 Playing Life Memberships will be awarded per year.
- Playing Life Member Benefits
 - Half price Association registration fees for life. (currently \$40)
